## ACT

No. 38 of 1990

Date of Assent: 23rd January, 1991

An Act to approve the excess expenditure of moneys aggregating one hundred and nine million, sixty thousand, seven hundred and forty-six kwacha required for the services of the Republic during the financial year which ended on 31st December, 1988.

ENAUTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Excess Expenditure Appropriation (1988) Act, 1990.

Short title

2. The expenditure on the services of the Republic during the financial year which ended on 31st December, 1988, of the moneys indicated in respect of those services in the third column of the Schedule, being expenditure in excess of the moneys appropriated for the services by the Appropriation Act, 1988, and the Supplementary Appropriation (1988) Act, 1989, is hereby approved.
