| 2. The Company specified in Part I of the Schedule shall be exempt from the payment of import licence fees under section <i>three A</i> of the Act in respect of the goods specified in Part II of the Schedule. | Exemption from import licence fees |
| 3. The goods in respect of which the organisations and agencies have been exempted under regulation 2 shall not be sold or disposed of to any person, organisation or agency not entitled to such exemption except with the written consent of the Minister and upon payment of the import licence fee in respect of those goods at the rate prevailing on the date of that sale or disposal. | Exempted goods not to be sold without permission |
