The Deputy Chief (Recognition) Order, 1996

WHEREAS the President, after consultation with the Chief and his traditional councillors, is satisfied that the person named in the Schedule hereto is entitled to hold the office specified therein as required by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section six of the Chiefs Act:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers contained in section six of the Chiefs Act, the following Order is hereby made:


