**The Small Claims Court (Limit of Jurisdiction)
(Liquidated Claims) Rules, 2009**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *five* of the Small Claims Court Act, The following Rules are hereby made:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Small Claims Court (Limit of Jurisdiction) (Liquidated Claims) Rules, 2009. Title
2. Subject to the Act, a small claims court has jurisdiction in all personal suits, whether arising from contract or tort or from both, where the value of the property, debt or damages claimed as a balance of accounts or otherwise, is not more than twenty million kwacha. Limit of Jurisdiction
