The National Assembly By-Election (Kabwata Constituency No. 77) (Election Date and Time of Poll) Order, 2022

Whereas in pursuance of Article 52(6) of the Constitution of Zambia, the Electoral Commission of Zambia has cancelled the election in respect of Kabwata Constituency No. 77 by reason of the resignation of the aspiring candidate Mr. Francis M. Libanda, after the close of nominations and before the election date.

Now THEREFORE in exercise of the powers contained in Articles 52(6) and 57(3) of the Constitution of Zambia, and Regulation 15(1) of the Electoral Process (General) Regulations, 2016, the following Order is made:

Cap. 1

- 1. This Order may be cited as the National Assembly By-Election (Kabwata Constituency No. 77) (Election Date and Time of Poll) Order, 2022.
- Title
- 2. A candidate for election as a Member of Parliament for Kabwata Constituency No. 77 shall lodge a nomination with the returning officer on Wednesday, 19th January, 2022, between 09.00 hours and 15.00 hours.

Nomination for election

3. The campaign period shall commence on Wednesday, 19th January, 2022 at 15.00 hours and close at 18.00 hours on Wednesday, 2nd February, 2022.

Campaign period

Election date and time of poll

- 4. (1) The poll for the election of a Member of Parliament in the constituency referred to in paragraph 2 shall be taken on Thursday, 3rd February, 2022, between 06.00 hours and 18.00 hours.
- (2) A poll shall not be taken in the constituency referred to in paragraph 2 if only one candidate is validly nominated for election. Made by the Electoral Commission of Zambia at Lusaka this 14th day of January, 2022.
