An Act to amend the Liquor Licensing Act

[15th April, 1983

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1983, and shall be read as one with the Liquor Licensing Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement. Cap. 429

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th January, 1983.

2. Section *eighty-two* of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of the full-stop and the substitution therefor of the following:

Amendment of section 82

and exempt any person or class of persons from the application of any provision of this Act or from the payment of all or any part of the appropriate fee.

3. The Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto is substituted therefor.

Where any licence is granted on or after the 1st July, one-half of the appropriate fee prescribed above shall be payable in respect of the period to the 31st December next following.

2. For the extension of permitted hours under the provisions of section 27 of the Act, there shall be paid a fee of six kwacha in respect of every hour or part thereof by which the permitted hours are extended.
