An Act to Amend the Gold Trade Act

[30th March, 1984

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Gold Trade (Amendment) Act, 1984, and shall be read as one with the Gold Trade Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement. Cap. 685

- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 28th January, 1984.
- 2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section seventeen and the replacement therefor of the following:

Repeal and replacement of section 17

17. For every licence to deal in gold, other than a Fees and licence to be a gold broker or factor, there shall be paid details of a fee of one thousand kwacha when the licence is first licences to deal in issued to a person, or a fee of five thousand kwacha when gold the licence is renewed, and every such licence shall be issued by the Minister and shall be in Form 1 in the Schedule:

Provided that every such licence shall, no matter when taken out, expire on the 31st December then next following.

- 3. Section eighteen of the principal Act is amended by the repeal of subsection (1) and the substitution therefor of the following:
 - (1) For every licence to be a gold broker or factor there shall be paid a fee of five hundred kwacha, and every such licence shall be issued by the Minister and shall be in Form 2 in the Schedule:

Amendment of section 18

Provided that every such licence shall, no matter when taken out, expire on the 31st December then next following.

4. Section twenty-one of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of "the sum of two kwacha" and the substitution therefor of "the sum of fifty kwacha".
