An Act to amend the Hotels Act

[30th March, 1984

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment) Act, 1984, and shall be read as one with the Hotels Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement.
Cap. 251

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 28th January, 1984.

2. Section *five* of the principal Act is amended by the insertion, immediately after subsection (3), of the following new subsection:

Amendment of section 5

(4) Every person issued with a licence under this section shall, at the time such licence is issued, pay the appropriate fee therefor as set out in the Schedule.

3. The principal Act is amended by the insertion, at the end thereof, of the Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto.
