

GOVERNMENT OF ZAMBIA

ACT

No. 31 of 1985

Date of Assent: 24th December, 1985

An Act to repeal and replace the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1981; to provide for revised salaries and allowances for the holders of offices to which Article 125 of the Constitution applies; and to provide for matters connected with or incidental to the foregoing.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1985.

Short title and commencement

(2) Sections *one* and *two* of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st October, 1985, and the other provisions shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1986

2. The holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule shall be paid—

Salaries and special allowances

(a) a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the second column of the First Schedule; and

(b) a special allowance at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the third column of the First Schedule:

Provided that the person who held the office of Auditor-General immediately before the commencement of this Act shall, while he continues to hold that office, be paid the special allowance at the annual rate of K3,000 instead of K1,800 as shown in the First Schedule.

Electricity and water allowances

3. The holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule shall be paid—

(a) an electricity allowance at the annual rate of K720; and

(b) a water allowance at the annual rate of K480.

Housing allowance

4. (1) The holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule shall be paid a housing allowance, if applicable, at the appropriate annual rate prescribed in the second column of the Second Schedule.

(2) No housing allowance shall be payable under subsection (1) to the occupier of housing provided by Government.

Other allowances

5. Nothing in this Act contained shall preclude the payment to the holder of an office specified in the First Schedule of any allowance not mentioned in this Act which he is eligible to receive otherwise than by virtue of the provisions of this Act.

Repeal of Act No. 1 of 1981

6. The Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1981, is hereby repealed.
