An Act to amend the Mineral (Export Tax) Act, 1983

[12th April, 1985

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Mineral (Export Tax) (Amendment) Act, 1985, and shall be read as one with the Mineral (Export Tax) Act, 1983, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement. Act No. 5 of 1983

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 26th January, 1985.

2. Section *four* of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by the deletion of " 8 per centum " and the substitution therefor of " 10 per centum ".

Amendment of section 4

3. The principal Act is amended in section *nine* by the addition thereto of the following proviso:

Amendment of section 9

Provided that the Minister may, by statutory instrument, exempt any person from the application of this section.
