An Act to amend the Defence Act

[31st December, 1987]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Defence (Amendment) Act, 1987, and shall be read as one with the Defence Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended by the insertion immediately after Part III of the following new Part:

HONORARY COMMISSIONS

12A. (1) The President may grant to deserving citizens of Zambia honorary commissions and may suspend, revoke or withdraw the commissions.

Grant of

(2) The President may delegate to any person any of his powers under subsection (1).

(3) The granting, suspension, revocation or withdrawal of an honorary commission shall be notified in the *Gazette*.

12B. (1) Subject to this Act, the President may, by statutory instrument, make regulations for the better carrying out of the provisions of this Part.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1), regulations made thereunder may deal with all or any of the following matters:

(a) the structure and categories of the honorary commissions;

- (b) the qualifications for eligibility for the honorary commissions and the criteria or conditions for the conferring of those commissions;
 - (c) the rights, privileges, benefits, duties and obligations to be attached to the honorary commissions;
 - (d) any uniforms or insignia to be worn or used in connection with the honorary commissions;
 - (e) the circumstances for the suspension, revocation or withdrawal of the honorary commissions; and
 - (f) any other matter that appears to the President to be expedient to be provided for in relation to the honorary commissions.
