An Act to amend the Constitution

[21st December, 1990

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution of Zambia (Amendment) Act, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Constitution.

Short Title

Cap. 1

2. The Constitution is amended—

Repeal of Article 4 and insertion of new Article 4A

(a) by the repeal of Article 4.

(b) by the insertion before Article 5 of the following new Article:

4A. Notwithstanding the repeal of Article 4—

Saving of existing institutions and organs of the Party

(a) the institutions and the organs of the Party recognised under this Constitution shall continue to exist until the next dissolution of Parliament; and

(b) any party formed as a consequence of the repeal of Article 4 shall only participate in an election to the National Assembly after the next dissolution of Parliament.

3. The Constitution is amended by the repeal of Article 64 and the substitution therefor of the following Article:

Repeal and replacement of Article 64

64. The National Assembly shall consist of—

Composition of National Assembly

(a) one hundred and fifty elected members; and

(b) the Speaker of the National Assembly.
