An Act to amend the Trades Licensing Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Trades Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Trades Licensing Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1991.

2. The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Appendix is substituted therefor.
