**An Act to amend the Liquor Licensing Act**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

**Enactment**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Liquor Licensing Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on 1st January, 1991.

## 1. Fees for the grant or renewal of a—

Where any licence is granted on or after 1st July, one-half of the appropriate fee prescribed above shall be payable in respect of the period to the 31st December next following.

2. For the extension of permitted hours under the provisions of section *twenty-seven* of the Act, there shall be paid a fee of forty kwacha in respect of every hour or part thereof by which the permitted hours are extended.
