An Act to amend the Mines and Minerals Act

[1st April, 1992

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia

1. This Act may be cited as the Mines and Minerals (Amendment) Act, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Mines and Minerals Act hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended by the insertion immediately after section *four* of the following new section:

4A. Every person issued with a licence, permit or authorisation under this Act shall;

(a) at the time of issue of such licence, permit or authorisation pay the prescribed basic licence fee;

(b) at the time of issue, and on each anniversary date thereafter, pay the prescribed annual area charges for as long as the licence, permit or authorisation remains in force.

3. Section *seventy* of the principal Act is repealed and the the following section substituted therefor:

70. The fees payable on the issue or renewal of a permit or licence or authorisation and as area charges shall be as prescribed by the Minister

4. Subsection 2 of section *one-hundred and twenty-three* is amended by--

(i) the insertion immediately after paragraph (j) of the following new paragraph (k).

“(k) the fees to be paid in respect of the issue or renewal of a licence or permit authorisation or as area charges.”

(ii) by the re-numbering of paragraph (k) as paragraph (l).
