ACT

No. 32 of 1992

Date of Assent: 27th July, 1992

An Act to provide for revised salaries for holders of offices to which Article 105 of the Constitution applies; to repeal the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1985; and to provide for matters connected with or incidental to the foregoing.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1992.

(2) Paragraph (a) of section *two* shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st of July, 1991.

(3) Paragraph (b) of section *two* shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 1992.

2. The holder of an office specified in the first column of the Schedule shall be paid—

Salary

(a) as from 1st July, 1991, a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the second column of the Schedule; and

(b) as from 1st April, 1992, a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the third column of the Schedule.

3. The Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1985, is hereby repealed.
