## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT NO. 20 OF 1984

**The Customs and Excise Act**  
(Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)

**The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties)**  
**(Amendment) Regulations, 1984**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties) (Amendment) Regulations, 1984, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

7 (b)	Gas oil (diesel oil), when taken out of bond for use in an approved scheme for the transportation of persons by an organisation approved by the Minister	K2.20 per dekalitre at 20° Celsius
