(No. 2) Regulations, 1988

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1988, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Suspension) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

Ex.28.31.13	Calcium hypochlorite, when imported for use as a water purification chemical	Free
Ex.39.02.29	Polyethylene and polypropylene	Free
Ex.84.61.00	Inner-tube valves, when imported by persons approved by the Minister, for use in the manufacture of inner-tubes	15%
