**The Chiefs (Recognition) (No. 4) Order, 1989**

WHEREAS the President is satisfied that the person named in the Schedule to this Order is entitled to hold the office specified in it as required by subsection (2) of section *three* of the Chiefs Act:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers contained in section *three* of the Chiefs Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Chiefs (Recognition) Title  
(No. 4) Order, 1989.

2. The person named in the Schedule to this Order is Recognition  
hereby recognised as being, within the area in Zambia of chief  
described in the Schedule, the holder of the office therein specified.
