**The Local Authority Market (Amendment) Regulations,
1989**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *five* of the Markets Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Authority Market (Amendment) Regulations, 1989, and shall be read as one with the Local Authority Market Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulation (1) by the deletion of the proviso and the substitution thereof of the following new proviso:

Provided that the maximum price determined under these Regulations shall not be higher than the maximum price fixed by any other written law for sale by retail of the same article of food.

3. The principal Regulations are amended by the addition after regulation 13 of the following new regulation:

14. Any person who contravenes these Regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction—

Penalty

(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding one hundred kwacha or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months, or both;

(b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding one hundred kwacha or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or both.
