STATUTORY INSTRUMENT NO. 29 OF 1990

The Customs and Excise Act
(Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)The Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Brake and Clutch
Company Limited) Regulations, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Brake and Clutch Company Limited) Regulations, 1990.

Title

2. (1) The Controller shall remit the whole duty payable on goods set out in the Schedule to these Regulations when imported by Brake and Clutch Company Limited up to a value of approximately one hundred and thirteen thousand, five hundred and ninety-two pounds.

Remission
of duty

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under sub-regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free of duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.
