**The Roads and Road Traffic Act
(Laws, Volume XV, Cap. 766)****The Roads and Road Traffic (Certificate of Fitness)
(Amendment) Regulations, 1992**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *two hundred and fifty-eight* of the Roads and Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Roads and Road Traffic (Certificate of Fitness) (Amendment) Regulations, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Roads and Road Traffic (Certificate of Fitness) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

(1) The fees at items 3 and 4 apply only if the motor vehicle or trailer is produced for re-examination by the notified date. If not so produced the fees shown at items 1 and 2 apply.
