**The Roads and Road Traffic Act**  
(Laws, Volume XV, Cap. 766)

**The Roads and Road Traffic (Certificate of Fitness) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *two hundred and fifty-eight* of the Roads and Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Roads and Road Traffic (Certificate of Fitness) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994, and shall be read as one with the Roads and Road Traffic (Certificate of Fitness) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

(2) These Regulations shall come into effect on the expiration of a period of thirty days after the date on which they are published in the *Gazette*.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the Second Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto is substituted therefor.

## PRESCRIBED FEES

	K
1. Examination of motor vehicle	6,000
2. Examination of trailer	4,500
3. Re-examination of motor vehicle	4,500
4. Re-examination of trailer	2,400
5. Duplicate of any document prescribed in these Regulations	2,400
6. Appeals to the Commissioner	13,500

## NOTES:

- (1) The fees at items 3 and 4 apply only if the motor vehicle or trailer is produced for re-examination by the notified date. If not so produced, the fees shown at items 1 and 2 apply.
- (2) No fee is payable for an examination under section 171 of the Act if no defect is discovered, nor for examination under section 172.
- (3) Refer to Regulation 9 for detailed provisions.
