The Immigration and Deportation (Amendment)

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *thirty-one* of the Immigration and Deportation Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration and Deportation (Amendment) Regulations, 1995, and shall be read as one with the Immigration and Deportation Regulations, in these Regulations, referred to as the principal Regulations.
