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**The Customs and Excise Act**  
(Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)

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**The Customs and Excise (Importation of Capital Equipment  
for Road Construction) (Remission) Regulations, 1995**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

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| <p>1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Importation of Capital Equipment for Road Construction) (Remission) Regulations, 1995</p>   | Title     |
| <p>2. (1) The Commissioner shall remit the whole of the duty on the equipment imported by the construction companies listed in the Appendix to these Regulations for the purpose of the indicated projects:</p> | Remission |

Provided that any such equipment or plant presented to the Commissioner shall have been cleared with the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Works and Supply and certified as essential to the respective road project prior to application to the Commissioner.

(2) The equipment on which duty has been remitted under sub-regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to buy them free of duty except with the consent of the Commissioner and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate levied at the date of such sale or disposal.
