IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *sixty-nine* and *seventy-six* of the Local Government Act, the following By-laws are hereby made:

These By-laws may be cited as the Mumbwa District Council (Maize Levy) (Amendment) By-laws, 1998 and shall be read as one with the Mumbwa District Council (Maize Levy) By-laws, 1995, in these By-laws referred to as the principal By-laws.</p> <p>2. The principal By-laws are amended by the revocation of by-law 5 and the substitution therefor of the following:</p> <p>5. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, upon conviction—</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding sixty penalty units or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or to both; and</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding sixteen penalty units for every day during which the offence continues or to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to both.</p> | <p>Title</p> <p>S.I. Offences and
penalties

6. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction—

(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding six penalty units or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months, or to both; and

(b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding eleven penalty units for every day during which the contravention continues or to imprisonment not exceeding six months, or to both.
