**The Environmental Protection and Pollution Control Act
(Laws, Volume 12, Cap. 204)****The Pesticides and Toxic Substances (Amendment)
Regulations, 2000**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *ninety-six* of the Environmental Protection and Pollution Control Act and in consultation with the Council, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pesticides and Toxic Substances (Amendment) Regulations, 2000 and shall be read as one with the Pesticides and Toxic Substances Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

The fee payable shall be 8,667 fee units per product for the imported chemical.
