| 3. A person who sells vegetables within the area or exports vegetables from the area shall pay to the Council a vegetable levy calculated at the following rates: | |
| (a) five hundred kwacha per every box of tomatoes; | |
| (b) five hundred kwacha per twenty five kilogramme of cabbage, potato, rape, onion, paprika and okra. | |
