IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eight-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Manufacturing Inputs) (Amendment) Regulations, 2008, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Manufacturing Inputs) Regulations, 1994, in these Regulations referred as the principal Regulations.</p> <p>(2) These Regulations shall come into effect on 26th January, 2008.</p> <p>2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is amended —</p> <p>(a) in sub-regulation (2) by the deletion of paragraph (b) and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:</p> <p>(b) the submission by the importer of written evidence that the cost of production based on normal customs duty rates on the manufacturing inputs would render the output uncompetitive in price against similar imported goods; and</p> <p>(b) in sub-regulation (3) by the deletion in paragraph (c) of the words " sub-paragraphs (i) and (ii) of ".</p> | <p>Title</p> <p>S.I.
