**The Zambia National Service (Combat Uniform)
Regulations, 2013**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *fifty* of the Zambia National Service Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Zambia National Service (Combat Uniform) Regulations, 2013. | Title |
| 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—
“combat uniform” means the uniform described in the Schedule;
“member” has the meaning assigned to it in the Act; and
“Service” means the Zambia National Service established under section <i>three</i> of the Act. | Interpretation |
| 3. (1) The combat uniform described in the Schedule is the official and exclusive combat uniform for members of the Service.
(2) The service shall provide a member with a combat uniform for purposes of performing the duties specified in the Act.
(3) A member shall, in performing any function under the Act, wear the combat uniform. | Combat uniform for service |
| 4. (1) A person who is not a member shall not wear or use the combat uniform. | Prohibition of use of combat uniform |

(2) A person who contravenes sub-regulation (1) commits an offence and is liable, of conviction, to a fine not exceeding two thousand five hundred penalty units or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two years, or to both.
