STATUTORY INSTRUMENT NO. 40 OF 2015

The Customs and Excise Act
(Laws, Volume 18, Cap. 322)**The Customs and Excise (Customs Duty) (Suspension)**
(Wheat) Regulations, 2015

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Customs Duty) (Suspension) (Wheat) Regulations, 2015. Title and commencement and revocation
- (2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 17th March, 2015, and stand revoked on 31st August, 2015.
2. (1) The customs duty on wheat shall be suspended to zero where wheat is imported by a holder of an import permit issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock. Suspension of customs and excise duty
- (2) Subject to sub-regulation (1), an import permit holder shall be permitted to import the wheat grain free of customs duty if the wheat grain falls within the codes specified in the Schedule and does not exceed the tonnage specified in the Schedule
3. Statutory Instrument No. 23 of 2015 is revoked. Revocation of S. I. No. 23 of 2015
