Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is amended by the insertion of the following new subregulation immediately after subregulation(4):</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(5) An aircrew officer who resigns from employment in the Regular Force is liable to pay to the Government the total sum of the monies paid by the Government for that aircrew officer's training from ground school to the date of that aircrew officer's resignation.</p> | <p>Amendment

Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is amended by the—</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">(a) insertion of the following new subregulation immediately after subregulation (1):</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(2) Despite subregulation(1) in relation to the length of service required before a permanent service officer may retire from employment, in the Regular Force but subject to the other provisions of this regulation, a permanent service officer who is an aircrew officer and whose pensionable service amounts to not less than twenty years may retire from employment in the Regular Force;</p> | <p>Amendment

- (c) in subregulation (5), by the deletion of the figure “3” and the substitution therefor of the figure “4”; and
- (d) in subregulation (6), by the deletion of the figure “4” and the substitution therefor of the figure “5”.
