**The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Wheat)
Regulations, 2023**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 89 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Wheat) Regulations, 2023.

Title,
Commence-

revocation

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 12th April, 2023, and shall stand revoked on 31st August, 2023.

2. (1) The duty on wheat of heading 1001.19.00 and 1001.91.90 is suspended to zero when the wheat is imported by a holder of an import permit issued by the Ministry responsible for agriculture.

Suspension
of duty

(2) The suspension of duty under subregulation (1) applies where the companies specified in the Schedule import the quantities specified in that Schedule.
