JUDGMENT

This is an action commenced by way of Originating summons pursuant to Section 19(2) of the Intestate Succession Act, Chapter 59 of the Laws of Zambia.

The application is supported by an affidavit sworn by the Applicant who is also

the Administrator of the estate of the late Justo Chalunda Mwale and her

siblings. It is deposed that the late died on 12th December 1995, and on 16th

January 2018, the 1st Applicant was appointed Administrator of the estate, as

shown on exhibit 'ACM' the letters of Administration issued by the Probate

Registry of the High Court.

The Applicants also depose that at the time of his death, the late was married

and had four (4) children, and no dependants.

The affidavit also states that there is a property number Sub division B Lot

3973/M Lusaka which the beneficiaries agree should be sold and proceeds

shared as shown on exhibit 'ACM2'.

I have considered the matter. Exhibit 'ACM1' the letter of administration shows

that the late Justo Chalunda Mwale died intestate on 12th December, 1995. His

estate therefore falls to be distributed in line with the Intestate Succession Act,

Chapter 59 of the Laws of Zambia.

The Applicants have applied pursuant to Section 19(2) of the said Act to have

the property forming the estate to be sold. The section empowers the

Administrator of the estate of sell any property under the estate with the

authority of the Court.

The affidavit evidence shows that the four Applicants are the only beneficiaries

under the estate. I therefore order that the 1st Applicant being the

Administrator of the estate shall sell the property under the estate, being B Lot

3973/M Lusaka, and shall share the proceeds equally among the surviving

beneficiaries being the four Applicants.
