## **PETITION**

The Petition of ALBERT MUNANGA of Lusaka in the Lusaka District of the Republic of Zambia SHOWETH that:

- 1. Your Petitioner ALBERT MUNANGA is a person who was a candidate at the aforesaid election.
- Your Petitioner ALBERT MUNANGA states that the election was held on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2021 when STEPHEN KAMPYONGO for the Patriotic Front (PF) was declared as being duly elected.
- 3. Your Petitioner polled 7,214 votes against the 1st Respondent's 16,451 votes.
- 4. And the Petitioner says that STEPHEN KAMPYONGO was not duly elected because the elections in the said Constituency were held in an atmosphere which was not free and fair due to widespread malpractices, vote buying, bribery and corruption.

- 5. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent being a former Minister of Home Affairs engaged in various acts of violence against other candidates and their campaign agents for both parliamentary and local government elections with impunity.
- At the instruction of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent cadres belonging to the PF damaged a motor vehicle Toyota Landcruiser registration number ABG 6830 at Mukokile Camp on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2021.
- 7. On 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2021 the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent acting together with Ms. Evelyn Kangwa directed the Police to impound a Fuso Fighter truck which motor vehicle was being used for campaigns by the Petitioner and the same was detained by the Police for 34 days to the detriment of the Petitioner.
- 8. The Petitioner further says that the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent through a Mr. S. Bwali (the PF Council Chairperson candidate) and campaign agents masquerading as PF cadres assaulted Mr. Derick Simuchindo the United Party for National Development (UPND) candidate for Councillor in Mayembe Ward.
- 9. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent through his agents namely Sokopipo, Sebastian, and other unknown PF cadres brutally assaulted Mr. Michael Sichone (the UPND Council Chairperson candidate) together with his family at his home on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021 for no reason apart from being a candidate on the UPND ticket.
- 10. On 8<sup>th</sup> July 2021 the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent instructed potential voters at a rally held at Matumbo Village not to allow any other political party candidate hold a campaign meeting in the area.
- 11. The Petitioner was denied permission to hold a campaign meeting at Matumbo Village on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021 on the orders of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent and Ms. Evelyn Kangwa the District Commissioner.
- 12. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent in the company of Ms. Evelyn Kangwa opened a mortuary at Matumbo Health Centre on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021 for purposes of inducing the electorate in the area to vote for him.
- 13. On 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021 Andrew Kapasa Kalulu, the Parliamentary candidate in the same election standing on the Socialist Party ticket, was brutally assaulted and left unconscious by PF cadres and members of the PF in the presence of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent.

This incident which was captured on video occurred as the said Andrew Kalulu was on a campaign trail in Mwiche and Ichingo wards respectively as per approved ECZ campaign timetable.

- 14. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent commissioned a health post at Mutitima Village on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and during the opening ceremony he threatened the community not to vote for the Petitioner if they were to be allowed to access services at the health post.
- 15. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent was capture on video donating K1000 to villagers at Mwilwa Village on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2021 purportedly as a contribution towards a community clinic project when it was for purposes of inducing the villagers to vote for him the following day.
- 16. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent's agent, Ms. Evelyn Kangwa the District Commissioner, went to Chiseko Primary School, a polling station, on election day and threatened to chase and demolish all houses belonging to members of the UPND in Chiseko Village.
- 17. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent ordered the presiding officer at Matumbo Polling Station through a phone call to allow Andrew Kampyongo (his brother), Mwamba Matumbo, S. N. Mutale and others unknown to vote when they were not registered voters at the polling station.
- 18. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent's agents namely Andrew Kampyongo, Mathews Chilekwa and Phily Sinkala brutally assaulted UPND members at Kalalantekwe on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021 an incident which was captured on video.
- 19. The 1st Respondent's agent Evelyn Kangwa (the District Commissioner) acting with other unknown PF cadres stopped polling agents for the Petitioner from entering the polling station at Kasashi Polling Station on election day. Similarly, the same 1st Respondent's agent threatened voters on the queue at Kasangala Polling Station on the basis that it was past 6pm and voting was closed contrary to the provisions of the law on voting after 6pm on polling day.
- 20. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent's agent Evelyn Kangwa (the District Commissioner) supplied Disaster Management and Mitigation Unit relief mealie meal to PF cadres who in turn distributed the same to would be voters on their way to vote on election day.
- 21. The 1st Respondent's agent the Headman of Macheleta Village threatened villagers in his village on election day with reprisals of removing them from the list of social cash

recipients as well as confiscation of bicycles given to them by the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent if they did not vote for the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent.

- 22. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent forced poll staff at Matumbo Polling Station to allow an unregistered voter, Anthony Makwaya, to vote using his father's voter's card and national registration card on election day.
- 23. The 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent was seen on election day giving cash handouts of K20 notes to voters on their way to various polling stations as an inducement to vote for him.

WHEREOF the Petitioner prays that it may be determined that;

1) The said **Stephen Kampyongo** was not duly elected or returned and the election was void.
