Previous conviction—meaning of “previous”.

In the judgment hereunder the meaning of “previous conviction” is explained.

Wilson, A.J.: Sentences in both cases confirmed.

Please point out to the Magistrate that the “previous” conviction which I have marked was subsequent to the offences of which the convict has now been convicted. “Previous” means previous to a subsequent offence not merely to a subsequent conviction.
