LOAN AGREEMENT

The Loan Agreement between the Danish Government (as Lenders) and the Government of the Republic of Zambia (as Borrowers) for an amount of about eighty-five million Danish Kroner (D.Kr.85,000,000) which is about seventeen million thirty-eight thousand kwacha (17,038,000) to be signed some time in March or April, 1985, or soon thereafter.

CONSTITUTION OF THE PARTY

United National Independence Party Regulations  
(Amendment) Regulations, 1985

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Article 65 of the Constitution of the United National Independence Party, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the United National Independence Party Regulations (Amendment) Regulations, 1985 and shall be read as one with the United National Independence Party Regulations, 1983, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 95 of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (e) of sub-regulation (1) by the addition of the following:

- (e) General Manager, NAMBOARD;  
General Manager, Cold Storage Board of Zambia;  
General Manager, Dairy Produce Board;  
Director, Zambia National Provident Fund;  
Deputy Director, Zambia National Provident Fund;

UNIP Regulations (Amendment) Regulations

THE NATIONAL INDEPENDENT PARTY

CONSTITUTION OF THE PARTY

ARTICLE 1

The name of the party shall be the National Independent Party.

The objects of the party shall be to secure the independence, unity and integrity of the State and to promote the welfare of the people.

The party shall be a democratic party and shall be committed to the principles of democracy and the rule of law.

The party shall have a central committee which shall be responsible for the general direction and control of the party.
