## The Customs and Excise (Approved Organisations) Order, 1985

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, as read with regulation 22 (I) of the Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) Regulations, the following Order is hereby made:

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Approved Organisations) Order, 1985.

Title and commencement

- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 25th January, 1985.
- 2. (1) The organisations or agencies set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby approved for the purposes of regulation 22 (1) of the Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) Regulations.

Approval of organisations, p. 498/1

(2) Every scheme or programme financed or aided by any organisation or agency approved by sub-regulation (1) shall qualify for a rebate, refund or remission in accordance with the said regulation 22 (1) if such aid or financing is under the auspices of an agreement to which the Republic is a party and by virtue of which such scheme or programme is entitled to such rebate, refund or remission.
