| <p>1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Beede Trading and Manufacturing Limited) Regulations, 1987.</p> <p>2. (1) The Controller shall remit the whole duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto when imported by Beede Trading and Manufacturing Limited up to a value of approximately one hundred and twenty-six thousand and two hundred kwacha.</p> <p>(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under sub-regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free of duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.</p> | <p>Title</p> <p>Remission of duty</p> |
