STATUTORY INSTRUMENT NO. 1 OF 1990

**The Births and Deaths Registration Act**  
(Laws, Volume IV, Cap. 210)**The Births and Deaths Registration (General)**  
(Amendment) Rules, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-one* of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, the following Rules are hereby made:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (General) (Amendment) Rules, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Births and Deaths Registration (General) Rules, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules.

2. The principal Rules are amended by the revocation of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the Second Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto.

Registration of name subsequent to registration of birth .. .. .	10.00
Registration of alteration in name .. .. .	10.00
On every search covering a period of ten years at the office of the Registrar-General or of a Registrar .. .. .	20.00

No fees are chargeable for registration of birth or death if notice is given within one month.
