**The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties)  
(Vehicles Imported in a Completely Knocked Down  
Condition) Regulations, 1993**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties) (Vehicles Imported in a Completely Knocked Down Condition) Regulations, 1993.

Title

2. The duties appearing in Heading No. 9 of the Excise Tariff set out in the Second Schedule to the Act, in so far as they apply to vehicles imported in a completely knocked down condition, are suspended to free.
