The Shangombo District Council (Cattle Levy) By-laws, 1999

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *sixty-nine* and *seventy-six* of the Local Government Act, the following By-laws are hereby made:

| 1. These By-laws may be cited as the Shangombo District Council (Cattle Levy) By-laws, 1999. | Title |
| 2. In these By-laws, unless the context otherwise requires—
“area” means the area under the jurisdiction of the Shangombo District Council;
“check-point” means any place within the area designated by the Council for the payment of cattle levy;
“collector” means any officer of the Council authorised to collect cattle levy for the Council;
“Council” means the Shangombo District Council; and
“movement permit” means a permit issued by a Veterinary officer under the provisions of the stock diseases regulations. | Interpretation |
| 3. Any person who sells cattle within the area or exports cattle from the area shall pay to the Council a cattle levy at the rate of two thousand kwach per head. | Imposition of Cattle levy  |
| 4. No person shall sell cattle within the area or export cattle from the area for which no cattle levy has been paid to the Council. | No sale of cattle without payment of cattle levy |
| 5. Cattle levy shall become payable at any check-point and shall be received by a collector who shall immediately issue an official receipt for each such payment. | Place of payment and collection of cattle levy |

Offences and
penalties

6. (1) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction—

(a) in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding eighty penalty units or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both;

(b) in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding sixteen penalty units for each day during which the contravention continues.

(2) In addition to any penalty prescribed by sub-by-law (1), the Court may order that any expenses incurred by the Council in consequences of such contravention be paid by the person committing the contravention.
