Now THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers contained in Regulation 8 of the said Regulations, the following Order is here by made:

1. This Order may be cited as the National Assembly By-Elections (Mbabala Constituency No. 116 and Mfuwe Constituency No. 99) (Election Dates and Times of Poll) Order, 2000.

- 2. Nominations for elections in the constituencies referred to in paragraph 1 shall be lodged with the returning officer on Thursday 3rd February, 2000, between 0900 hours and 1500 hours.

- 3. The poll in the constituencies referred to in paragraph 1 shall be taken on Thursday, 17th February, 2000 between 0600 hours and 1700 hours:

Poll and elections

Provided that no such poll shall be taken in the constituency if only one candidate has been validly nominated for the election.
