The National Forest No. F 11, Lushishi (Alteration of Boundaries) Order, 2007

SCHEDULE
(Paragraph 2)

NATIONAL FOREST NO. F 11, LUSHISHI

Starting at the point where the right bank of Mushishima river crosses the line CG302-CG303, the boundary follows the western boundary of lot 661/M to beacon LF1; thence south-westerly direction on a bearing of 190 degrees for a distance of approximately 6,640 metres to beacon LF2; thence south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 2,100 metres to beacon MB114; thence northwards in a straight line on a bearing of 358 degrees for a distance of approximately 4,200 metres to beacon MB116; thence in a north-easterly direction in a straight line on a bearing of 26 degrees for a distance of approximately 1,150 metres through MB121 to a point on the right bank of Mushishima river; thence generally northwards along the right bank of Mushishima river for a

distance of approximately 9,200 metres to the point where the right bank of Mushishima river crosses the line CG302-CG303 the point of starting.

The above described area in extent 3,513 Hectares approximately is shown bordered green on Plan No. P.446/1 deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General signed by him dated 19th June, 2006.
