The Customs and Excise Act
(Laws, Volume 18, Cap. 322)**The Customs and Excise (Suspension)(Development
Aid from People to People) Regulations, 2009**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Development Aid from People to People) Regulations, 2009.

Title

2. (1) The Commissioner-General shall suspend the whole duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule to these Regulations when imported by Development Aid from People to People.

Suspension
of duty

(2) The amount of duty which has been suspended shall not be applied otherwise than to the programmes specified in the Memorandum of Understanding signed on the 2nd of June, 2009, between Development Aid from People to People and the Ministry responsible for community development.


