The Customs and Excise Act
(Laws, Volume 18, Cap. 322)

The Customs and Excise (Remission) (TGP Properties Limited) Regulations, 2010

IN EXCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations hereby are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remission) (TGP Properties Limited) Regulations, 2010.

Title and

(2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into effect on 1st January, 2010, and shall cease to have effect on 31st December, 2015.

2. (1) The Commissioner-General shall remit the whole duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule to these Regulations when purchased or imported by TGP Properties Limited up to the value of one hundred seventy-one million United States dollars.

Remission
of duty

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under sub regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them duty free, except with the consent of the Commissioner-General and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.
