| <p>1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Obligatory Test Certificate) (Exemption) Regulations, 2016, and shall come into operation on the expiration of a period of thirty days from the date on which they are published in the <i>Gazette</i>.</p> | Title and commencement |
| <p>2. The Minister may, upon application by an importer, dealer or manufacturer of a re-conditioned motor vehicle, exempt the importer, dealer or manufacturer of the re-conditioned motor vehicle from obtaining an obligatory test certificate for a period of three years.</p> | Exemption |
| <p>3. The Roads and Road Traffic (Obligatory Test Certificate) (Exemption) Regulations, 1989, are revoked.</p> | Revocation of S. I. No. 61 of 1989 |
