**The Customs and Excise (Electronic Machinery and
Equipment) (Suspension) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2022**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 89 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Electronic Machinery and Equipment) (Suspension) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Electronic Machinery and Equipment) (Suspension) Regulations, 2021, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.
