# The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Fuel) (No. 2) Regulations, 2022

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 89 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Fuel) (No. 2) Regulations, 2022, and shall come into operation on 16th January, 2022, and stand revoked on 30th June, 2022.

Title, Commencement and Revocation

- 2. (1) The customs duty on petroleum spirit (motor spirit) of heading 2710.12.10, automotive gas oil (diesel) of heading 2710.19.10, kerosene of heading 2710.12.51 and liquefied petroleum gas of heading EX 27.11 is suspended to the extent shown in the First Schedule where the petroleum spirit (petrol), automotive gas oils (diesel), kerosene and liquefied petroleum gas is imported or purchased from a bonded warehouse by an oil marketing company as authorised by the ministry responsible for energy and notified in the *Gazette*.
- Suspension of customs duty

(2) The total quantities of petroleum spirit (petrol), automotive gas oil (diesel), kerosene and liquefied petroleum gas suspended under subregulation (1) are specified in the Second Schedule.
