Animal Health Act (Act No. 27 of 2010)

African Swine Fever Outbreak in Lusaka Province

IN ACCORDANCE with Sections 12, 13, 22, and 23 of the Animal Health Act No. 27 of 2010 of the Laws of Zambia, it is hereby notified for the information of the public in general and the farming community and livestock purveyors in particular that African Swine Fever (ASF), a disease of domestic and wild pigs, has broken out in Lusaka Province.

In view of this outbreak, the under listed measures will be in force in Lusaka Province with immediate effect until further notice:

- 1. Movement of all pigs and pig products within and out of the affected areas have been banned as follows:
 - (a) No live pigs, pig carcasses, pig or pork products will be allowed in Lusaka Province
 - (b) No live pigs, pig carcasses, pig or pork products will be allowed, into or out of Lusaka Province.
 - (c) No live pigs, pig carcasses, pig or pork products will be allowed to move from one area to another within Lusaka Province
 - (d) Pigs, pig carcasses, pig or pork products will only be allowed to transit from any part of Zambia to another part of Zambia through Lusaka Province under strict conditions stipulated by the Department of Veterinary Services.
- All pig sale yards, slaughter facilities and processing plants in Lusaka Province have been closed with immediate effect until the disease is under control
- Veterinary officers in the affected areas will take any other such measures as deemed necessary for the control of the disease

Any animal found contravening the foregoing measures will be destroyed without compensation and the persons in charge of such animals will be prosecuted.

Any other person or persons found contravening the measures directly or indirectly will also be prosecuted.

A Declaration Relating to Procedure of Assignment of Scare Resources

THE Zambia Information and Communications Technology Authority [herein after called "the Authority"] having had regard to the availability as well as both actual and likely demand of the scarce resources listed in the schedule hereto, considers that the assignment of the said scarce resources accompanying relevant licences should be subject to a restricted granting procedure.

Pursuant to Section 54(6) of the Information and Communication Technologies Act No. 15 of 2009, the Authority hereby declarea that the scarce resources listed in the schedule hereto will be assigned through a restricted granting procedure which may, among others, include the following main features:

- 1. Only Licensees in possession of a Network (International Market Segment) licence qualify to participate in the process for the 800MHz band;
- 2. Only Licensees in possession of a Network (International Market Segment) licence and a Network (National) Licence qualify to participate in the process for the 2600MHz band:
- 3. Determination by the Authority of the reserve price applicable to the scarce resources;
- 4. Advertisement by the Authority of a Request for Applications (RFA) with prospective assignees required to pay a non- refundable application fee as indicated in the RFA;
- 5. Requirement by prospective assignees of the scarce resources which are listed in the schedule to submit to the Authority technical, financial and related proposals as shall be prescribed in the RFA;
- 6. Evaluation, by the Authority, of proposals received from prospective assignees for purposes of determining whether or not the prospective assignees have met the set criteria;
- Determination of qualifying proposals by the Authority;
- Assignment, by the Authority, of the scarce resources to qualifying licensees upon meeting any other applicable conditions indicated in the RFA.
